

2023 Series Point Guidelines

Revised: 03/20/2023

Historic Sportscar Racing (HSR) has five (5) year-long series in which points are awarded. Each series crowns a champion at the end of the year. These Series and the eligibility for each are as follows:

WeatherTech Sprint Races:

All sprint race classes, except those designated with an "X", are eligible for points.

B.R.M Chronographes Endurance Challenge

For the eligible class list, please refer to the 2023 Race & Enduro Classes document.

SascoSports International American Challenge

For the eligible class list, please refer to the 2023 Specialty Race Eligibility document.

Classic RS Cup

For the eligible class list, please refer to the 2023 Specialty Race Eligibility document.

stoner Car Care Global GT

For the eligible class list, please refer to the 2023 Specialty Race Eligibility document.

All classes designated with an "X" are ineligible for points, podiums, or other awards.

In general, points will be distributed as follows for each series:

Race Points

Sprint Race, SascoSports I/A Challenge, Stoner Car Care Global GT, Classic RS Cup, Enduros Points are based on the finishing position in CLASS (not overall) within the run Group. Must complete a minimum of 50% of the winner's laps in the Group to be eligible to receive points. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st Place 10 points, 2nd Place 8 points, 3rd Place 6 points, 4th Place 4 points, 5th Place 3 points, 6th Place 2 points and 7th Place 1point.

Bonus Points

Sprint Race, B.R.M Chronographes Endurance Challenge

One point awarded for each car, within the class, who starts the race and ends up behind the competitor, up to a maximum of 10 points. *Example: Finishing fourth in ten car field earns six (6) Bonus Points.*

Starting Points

Sprint Race, SascoSports I/A Challenge, Stoner Car Care Global GT, Classic RS Cup Five (5) points awarded for Starting the Race (defined as being listed on the official results as completing one (1) lap).

Finishing Points

Sprint Race, SascoSports I/A Challenge, Stoner Car Care Global GT, Classic RS Cup Ten points awarded for Finishing the Race (must complete at least 50% of the overall winner's laps to be eligible to receive finishing points).

Participation Bonus

Sprint Race, SascoSports I/A Challenge, Stoner Car Care Global GT, Classic RS Cup Competitors earn five (5) points for registering for and participating in all scheduled 2023 HSR race events. You are not required to participate in all schedule events within an event weekend.

Enduro Bonus

B.R.M Chronographes Endurance Challenge

In addition to Race Points, Competitors earn two (2) points for starting and three (3) points for finishing Sprint Race 2.

- ** Bonus points will not be awarded for overall finishing position **
- ** No Enduro Bonus Points will be awarded at Season Finale **
- ** No class designated with an "X" will be eligible for points in any series **

In 2023, there are six (6) race weekends available for those who are eligible to earn points:

Sebring Spring Fling

The Mitty

Watkins Glen Historics

Fall Historics

Daytona Historics

Sebring Historics

The best five (5) race weekends will be used to determine the overall winner. This gives each driver who competes in all six (6) events the ability to drop one (1) race weekend. Drivers may not drop a race weekend in which they are disqualified due to a technical or driving infraction.

Classic RS Cup

In 2023, there are four (4) race weekends available for those who are eligible for points:

Sebring Spring Fling

Fall Historics

Daytona Historics

Sebring Historics.

No drop race weekend available in Classic RS Cup.

How Points Will Be Awarded

Points will be awarded to the car and driver (combined) as listed on the entry form. Drivers will be allowed to change cars within the season and still accumulate points if the replacement car is in the same class as the original car.

Tie Breakers

In the event of a tie at year end, the following tie breakers, in this order, will determine the results:

- 1. Most Class Wins
- 2. Best average finishing position
- 3. Most events entered

The overall winner of each B.R.M Chronographes Endurance Challenge will receive one (1) limited edition B.R.M Chronograph designed specifically for HSR.
