HSR Flagtronics Mandate

Beginning the 2025 HSR Watkins Glen Classic 6 Hour event in June, Flagtronics in-car units will be mandatory in all cars in competition at HSR events. This means that all vehicles that have entered or will enter the HSR Classic 6 should have a Flagtronics incar unit.

Flagtronics Models FT200 or FT-RD (ideal for open-wheel cars and vehicles with tight cockpits) are the mandated models. The unit must be securely mounted (open cars must include sufficient suitable tether). The unit must be positioned inside the cockpit in such a way that the driver has a clear line of sight to the display. It is highly recommended that the driver be able to reach the buttons on the unit when buckled into the seat.

If you have not already, please order your Flagtronics unit from https://flagtronics.com/. You must order your Flagtronics in-car unit by June 2nd to ensure delivery prior to the Watkins Glen event. There is an HSR specific page and kit (HSR page on Flagtronics website). HSR will also have a limited supply of rental units during the event.

Note: This date does not include time to install the unit before traveling to the event, it is simply the latest shipping date from Flagtronics to ensure it will be received.

The full serial number for the Flagtronics in-car unit can be found etched into the bottom of the unit. Please write down this number before installing your in-car unit.

- If you have already mounted your in-car unit, there is a USB plug on the wiring harness of the unit. Once plugged in to your laptop, the unit will come up in a folder just like a USB flash drive. Inside the folder on your computer, you will find a .txt file that is named with your serial number (i.e., 20003654.txt).
- If you cannot access the USB port, then you must remove the unit from the vehicle and find the serial number on the bottom of the unit.

Please be sure to input this serial number into MERG (https://merg.hsrrace.com/) in your account under Manage an Existing Entry before arriving to the event. If you need assistance with this, here is a link to a help document. If your car is entered into multiple races, you must input the number multiple times into each entry.
