HSR Prototype Challenge presented by Michelin Enduro Rules Update

The HSR Prototype Challenge presented by Michelin Enduro at the Road Atlanta Classic 10 / Fall Historics event on September 16 – 20, 2026 has been changed from a 60-minute enduro to a 90-minute enduro. Please see the following rules amendments.

Pit Stops:

- 90-Minute Enduros require two (2) mandatory 5-minute pit stops. Both pit stops must be initiated within 70 minutes of the first attempt to start the race. The Race Clock begins at the first attempt at a green flag from the start stand. Pit stops cannot be initiated consecutively on the same lap; the car must pass the start/finish line on track before initiating the second pit stop.

Drive Time:

- Enduro starting driver must be Am. Am Driver must complete 30 minutes of drive time. Am Drive Time is designated by First Green Flag to Pit In.

Any other rule not explicitly addressed has not been modified in any way.
